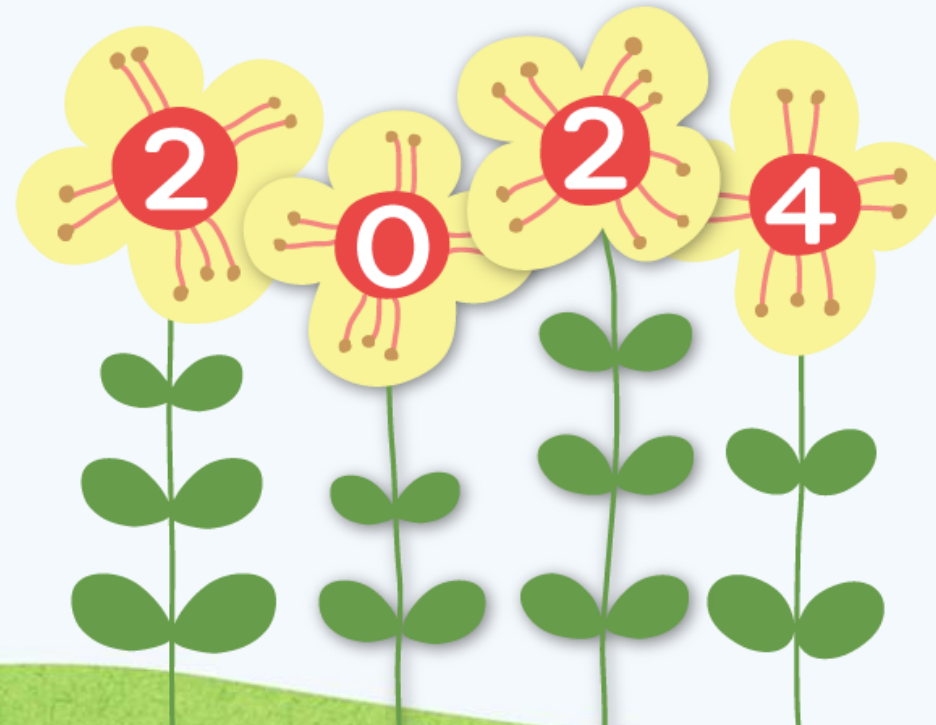

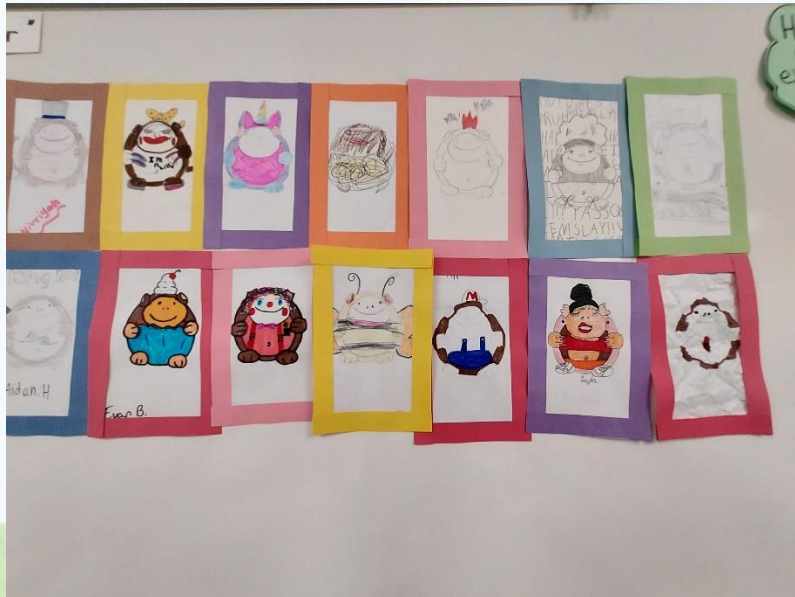

What to wear and bring to camp every day:

Camp Art!

- Comfortable clothes and closed toe shoes. Artists may bring a smock-type shirt that they don't mind getting paint and other permanent art materials on.
- Lunch and 2 snacks.
- Note: Refrigeration will not be available.
- Water bottle.
- Sunscreen and Bug Repellent.

Happy Campers/Ready! Set! Play!

- Comfortable clothes and closed toe shoes.
- One set of extra clothes in a Ziploc bag labeled with camper's name.
- Lunch (full-day campers) and a snack (1 half-day/2 full-day.)
Note: Refrigeration will not be available.
- Water bottle labeled with camper's name.
- Sunscreen and Bug Repellent.



Camp Communication

All parents should download the 'Skokie Parks Summer Camps' app to receive camp information!

Free features include:

- Live downloadable picture and video updates.
- Receive important push notifications, reminders, and texts.
- Stay connected with what's happening at camp daily.
- View camp calendars, schedules, and important dates.
- Easily access staff directory and contact information.

Tricks and Tips:

- Once the app is downloaded go to 'My Camp Settings' and select 'Edit' to select the camps your child(ren) are enrolled in.
- **Include your phone number to receive important texts from the camp staff.**
- Allow push notifications from the 'Skokie Parks Summer Camps' app to receive reminders.



Swimming and Pool Rules

District Wide Pool Policies:

- All campers, regardless of height, will be required to take the swimming test if they wish to have access to all areas of the pool.
- To pass the swimming test, the camper is required to swim the length of the pool without any breaks. The Skokie Park District's staff will determine 'pass' or 'fail' and will record it.
- Campers that do not take the swimming test or do not pass the swimming test will be issued a wristband. Campers issued a wristband should remain in shallow water. This is determined as water shallower than their own armpits.
- Campers that pass the swimming test can have access to all areas in the pool. This consists of water deeper than their own armpits, slides, and diving boards
- Swimming tests will be supervised by lifeguards and camp staff.
- Swimming tests will be available to campers every visit to the pool.
- Campers are welcome to retake the swim test as many times as they like to try.
- If the camper is in multiple camps, the camper will be required to take the test at each camp for which they are registered.
- Along with lifeguards, camp staff will be in and around the pool to provide extra supervision and monitor the wristbands.
- Campers will be asked to use the buddy system while swimming at the pool and using the locker room bathrooms. Buddies should have similar swim ability (update according to your own camp rules).

Camp Reminders

1. All campers **MUST** have a completed CIF on the first day of camp. Only those people listed on the CIF will be allowed to sign your camper out of camp. **ID must be shown at sign-out. No exceptions.**
2. **Drop-Off/Sign-In is from 9 – 9:30 am in Room 203 @ Oakton Community Center. Pick-Up/Sign-Out is from 12:00 – 12:30 pm Half-Day/3:30 – 4 pm Full-Day in Oakton Park.**
3. **If your camper will be absent, late or picked up early, please call Pamela at 847/929-7715 or email her at PZeid@skokieparks.org.**
4. Please be sure your camper brings at least 2 snacks, lunch (full-day campers,) a refillable water bottle and a towel to camp.
5. On water play days (8/8 & 8/10,) your camper should come to camp in their bathing suit. Full-day campers will need to bring a change of clothes, including underwear, with them to camp.
6. If your camper will need sunscreen or bug spray applied during camp, please complete the sunscreen/bug spray form and turn it in on the first day of camp. Also, please be sure to pack the sunscreen/bug spray in your camper's backpack.
