

## Bid Invitation: Basketball & Tennis Court Crack Repair & Color Coating Project

The Skokie Park District is now receiving bids for its Basketball and Tennis Court Crack Repair and Color Coating Project at its Park Services Facility. Bids are also available electronically by calling the Skokie Park District at (847) 929-7800. The scope of work includes basketball and tennis court crack repair and color coating at several sites. Bids shall be sealed in an envelope clearly marked "Skokie Park District Crack Repair and Color Coating Project" and delivered to Park Services, 7500 Frontage Rd., Skokie, IL 60077. Bids will be received until exactly 10 a.m. Thursday, August 8, 2019, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The Skokie Park District reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any technicalities in the bidding if it should be deemed in the public's best interest.

The work of this project is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq. A prevailing wage determination has been made by the Park District, which is the same as that determined by the IDOL for public works projects in Cook County. The contract entered into for the work will be drawn in compliance with said law and proposals should be prepared accordingly and provide payment for all laborers, workmen and mechanics needed to perform the work at no less than the prevailing rate of wages for each craft, type of worker or mechanic.

All bids must be accompanied by a cashier's check or bid bond payable to the Skokie Park District for ten prevent (10%) of the amount of the bid as provided in the Instructions to Bidders. No proposals will be considered unless accompanied by such a bond or check.
