Application Information

All completed applications must be received by Monday, March 13, 2026.

Eligibility

Skokie's Festival of Cultures will focus on the cultures represented within the wide ethnic diversity of Skokie, including but not limited to Asian, African-American, European, Filipino, Hispanic, Native American, Indian and Jewish. Exhibits, vendors and performers should further visitors understanding of a peoples way of living and may not promulgate specific religious or nationalist ideology.

Selection Criteria

The Skokie Festival of Cultures Committee will select applicants that best represent Skokie's cultural diversity. Decisions will be based on a completed application, entries that exemplify the traditional/ethnic arts, quality craftsmanship, ethnicity and prior participation in the Skokie Festival of Cultures event.

Performers must describe the performance and indicate which country/culture it represents. The sale of food items is strictly prohibited. The Skokie Festival of Cultures Committee reserves the right to reject any application which in the Committee's opinion, conflict with the Skokie Park District and Village of Skokie ordinances or are considered inappropriate for this event.

Weather

As is the case with all outdoor events, inclement weather may occur. Acts cancelled due to weather conditions will not be rescheduled. Please prepare yourself, performers instruments and props being used for the possibility of such weather with the appropriate protective measures. The Skokie Park District operations administrator and the sound engineers will determine whether to close down the outdoor stage events due to any inclement weather.
