You are cordially invited to participate in the Skatium Ice Arena's 46th Annual Ice Show which will be held on May 14, 15, 16, 17, 2020. This is a fun-filled experience and an opportunity to enjoy the wonderful world of show biz. There are five shows scheduled over four days (Thursday evening, Friday evening, Saturday afternoon and evening, and Sunday afternoon).

All Snowplow Sam 3 & Snowplow Sam 4, plus Basic 2 through Gold skaters who wish to order a costume and be a part of this year's show need to be registered in both the Winter and Spring sessions of the Skate School. Snowplow Sam 1, Snowplow Sam 2, Basic 1 & Basic 1 Advanced skaters, and Adults must be enrolled in the Spring session to be eligible for the show.

You must turn in the costume form to participate. There is a costume fee for skaters. However, they will be allowed to keep their costumes. All girl skaters will need to purchase white boot covers if they rent skates or if their own skates are not white. Girls will also need to have skin colored tights. Boys will need to provide their own black pants.

We ask that all parents and skaters attend all rehearsals and dress rehearsals. Rehearsals will begin 3 weeks before the show and will be held on the weekends. Additionally, there will be dress rehearsals on Monday, May 11 (Act 1) and Tuesday, May 12 (Act 2).

If your skater is in Intro to Free Skate and above, we invite your skater to be in a Production Number. It gives your skater a second opportunity to perform in the show.

Production A: Intro to Free Skate through Free Skate 2

Production B: Free Skate 3 through Free Skate 5

Production C: Free Skate 6 and Up

NEW THIS YEAR

Show Week: Skaters will have the opportunity to watch dress rehearsal on the rehearsal day they do not skate. For example, if your skater is in Act 1, they may watch the Act 2 dress rehearsal on Tuesday, May 12. The skaters will sit in their groups in the stands with a parental group volunteer. However, dress rehearsals remain closed to non-volunteer parents. The Running Order will be finalized by the end of March.

Boys: Basic 2 and up boys will have their own number in place of their skating level group. Intro to Free Skate and up boys are also eligible to sign up for their respective level Production Number.

Adults: All of our Adult Figure Skating Class skaters are invited to skate in their own number.

We hope that all skaters will join us in our annual ice show. Even those of you who are new and have never skated before will be progressing as the weeks pass and will not want to miss this opportunity.

ICE SHOW REHEARSAL SCHEDULE 2020

Monday, May 11: Act 1 Dress Rehearsal – Costumes Must Be Worn

Act 1 skaters, please be here at 5:45pm. This is a rehearsal for the technical people as well as the skaters. All skaters (except Snowplow Sam 1-4 & Basic 1), should be prepared to be at the arena until approximately 8:00pm. Skaters should eat before coming to the rink. Children will not have access to the concession stand. Skaters will be required to stay in their assigned dressing room. Parents WILL NOT be allowed in the bleachers or rink area during Dress Rehearsal Days.

Snowplow Sam 1 – Snowplow Sam 4 and Basic 1 skaters can be picked up at approximately 7pm. All other skaters should be picked up at approximately 8:00pm

If your skater is only in Act 2, they may watch the Act 1 Dress Rehearsal. The skater must arrive at 5:45pm in order to be seated with your group. Non-volunteer parents are not allowed to watch this closed rehearsal.

Tuesday, May 12: Act 2 Dress Rehearsal – Costumes Must Be Worn

Act 2 skaters, please be here at 5:45pm. This is a rehearsal for the technical people as well as the skaters. All skaters should be prepared to be at the arena until approximately 8:00pm. Skaters should eat before coming to the rink. Children will not have access to the concession stand. Skaters will be required to stay in their assigned dressing room. Parents WILL NOT be allowed in the bleachers or rink area during Dress Rehearsal Days.

If your skater is only in Act 1, they may watch the Act 2 Dress Rehearsal. The skater must arrive at 5:45pm in order to be seated with your group. Non-volunteer parents are not allowed to watch this closed rehearsal.

Wednesday, May 13: Extra Practice Day

If after Dress Rehearsal the Skating Director believes a group number needs an additional practice, we will schedule it for Wednesday afternoon and evening. The ice will also be made available for solo and duet practice. A schedule will be distributed the week of the show.

There will be an Act 1 Finale featuring the Snowplow 1-4 and Basic 1 skaters. All other skaters will be in the Act 2 Grand Finale.

Absolutely no performer will be allowed in the rink, lobby, or in the bleachers before, during or after the performance in costume or skates. **YOU MUST HAVE A CHANGE OF CLOTHES OR A FULL LENGTH COAT. NO EXCEPTIONS! NO SKATES ALLOWED IN THE STANDS!**

Skaters should be in costume and ready to skate when they are dropped off. Parents or friends are not permitted backstage. This will be strictly enforced in order to relieve backstage congestion and maintain safety & control. The skaters will be supervised when they are backstage. Volunteer parents will be there to help if any problems arise.

SKATE GUARDS – must be worn into the building if skates are put on at home. If you rent skates and do not own a pair of guards, you can pick up a used pair from the skate rental area when checking out your rental skates on Sunday, May 10th. Supply is limited. If you are unable to find a used pair of guards, then shoes must be worn to the rink.

SOLO COSTUMES: MARABOU or FEATHERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON ANY SOLO COSTUME. RHINESTONE TIGHTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.

TIGHTS: All female skaters need to wear flesh colored tights. For your convenience, these tights can be purchased in the Skatium's front office for \$12. No colored tights will be permitted. Rhinestone tights will also not be permitted.

VIDEO: DVD and show downloads will be available for purchase. These DVDs give parents the opportunity to maintain a video library of their child's skating progress. Parents: Due to limited space in the bleacher area, ONLY hand-held taping is allowed. You may use your own video recorder but only on a hand held, seated basis. Thank you for your cooperation.

PORTRAIT PHOTOGRAPHY: If you would like a professional photo of your skater, Blade Shots Photography will be at the Skatium on Friday evening and Saturday Evening from 6:15-8:30pm and during the Sunday Matinee from 1:30-3:00pm. You can make arrangements with the photographer at any of the above times.

PERMIT PARKING: Are you tired of hunting for a parking spot the night of the ice show? Now you don't have to! The Skokie Park District will be selling preferred parking passes for the Skatium's Ice Show. Ninety five parking permits will be sold for reserved parking spaces in the main parking lot. These parking passes can only be used for one show and you must select which night you would like in advance. Premiere parking passes are \$5.00 and must be purchased in advance. Sales begin on Sunday, May 3rd.

TICKETS: Tickets will go on sale for performers on Sunday, April 5 at 1:00pm. Limit of 10 tickets per skater. Unsold tickets will be made available to the general public on Saturday, April 11 at noon. All tickets are \$9.00 per seat. All show participants who wish to view this year's production during the official performances MUST have a ticket.

All children over the age of 1 MUST have a seat. **Lap sitting for toddlers is not permitted.** Car seats are not permitted. Space is limited! Please be courteous and do not put children on your lap.

All tickets including wheelchair and companion tickets will be sold online. If you require a seat-back, please reserve it in the office after you have ordered your tickets and have your seat numbers.

SKATE RENTAL – Starting Sunday, May 10th

There is no fee charged for rental skates for the ice show practice or the actual show. Parents may check out a pair of rental skates for the entire week on Sunday, May 10th from 9:00am-5:00pm. Your child will be able to use the same pair for practice and all shows. These skates are to be taken home between performances. A form will be distributed during your ice show rehearsal to reserve a pair of skates.
