

Welcome to the Skokie Park District Devonshire Playhouse auditions for *Perspectives: A Series of One Acts*. Recommended cast ages are 18+. Auditions are by appointment, but walk-ins will be accepted as time allows. Auditions are from 5-8P, Sunday, December 7 and 7-10P on Monday, December 8. Four one acts will be featured and led by four different directors. These include:

*Chicago* by Sam Shepard – directed by Tyler Skafgaard This play explores the complexities of love and survival in a threatening modern world.

Clean by Audrey Cefaly – directed by Amy Torf Two lonely souls share stories about their lives in an all-night diner

The Dumb Waiter by Harold Pinter – directed by Steven Yandell Two hired killers nervously await their next assignment

Man of the House by Robert Alan Blair – directed by Will Fisher A safecracker's job is complicated by an unusual case of mistaken identity.

#### Scenes

Actors should prepare a one-minute, dramatic or comedy monologue.

#### **Callbacks**

If there is a need for callbacks, these will be conducted on Tuesday, December 9/7-10P. Not receiving an invitation to callbacks does not mean that you will not be cast. It only means that we need a second look at certain actors together, in order to make final decisions on some characters. Actors being invited to callbacks will be asked to do cold readings from the script.

#### Rehearsal Schedule & Potential Conflicts

The tentative rehearsal schedule is included on the calendar in this packet. We begin with a read through Sunday, December 14 / 5-9P. We take a break from rehearsals for the holidays and begin rehearsals once more during the first week in January. A tentative rehearsal schedule is included in this packet. Please review this carefully to accurately report any conflicts. Not everyone will be called for every rehearsal but all cast members are expected to be at every rehearsal during the final two weeks prior to performance. A more detailed schedule is released after casting is complete and listed actor conflicts are taken into account.

We will send role offers out starting Wednesday, December 10 and will complete the process by Saturday, December 13. Actors have 24 hours to accept emailed notices.
