#### **Purchasing Procedure**

- 1. All purchases must be made in advance. There will be no on-site purchasing this year.
- 2. Staff will select the best plants available. For most species, there are two or more plants in each pot. All species are first-year plants and will bloom by their second or third year of growth.
- 3. Review the *Plant Requirements and Characteristics* and the *Native Plant Photo File* documents when making your selections.
- 4. Complete the order form with the <u>total quantity of each species</u> desired and with your contact information below.
- 5. Email your order form to EONC@SkokieParks.org.
- 6. Your order will be entered into our RecTrac purchasing system with an amount due. Adjustments will be made for sold out species.
- 7. Check your junk mail folder if you do not see your balance due receipt within 24 hours. Your user name will also be emailed to you.
- 8. Go online to <u>https://register.skokieparks.org/wbwsc/webtrac.wsc/splash.html</u> to log in to your Park District account and pay for your balance due with a credit card.

### Pick-up Procedure

- Bring your payment receipt to Emily Oaks on the next scheduled pick-up day (N/A) OR we can arrange a pick-up date, as well.
- 2. Please wear a mask during pick-up. Drive to the gate by the garage driveway and show your receipt to the staff.
- 3. Turn your engine off, and wait in your car.
- 4. Staff will bring your plants to your car and leave them near the vehicle.
- 5. After staff has stepped away, you may come out of your car to load the plants.
- 6. Empty pots can be returned in a paper bag <u>labelled</u> "plant pots" and left by the front door of the Visitor Facility.
