## AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING THE TAXES OF THE SKOKIE PARK DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE 1ST DAY OF MAY 2018 AND ENDING ON THE 30TH DAY OF APRIL 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF THE SKOKIE PARK DISTRICT COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of Eight Million, Eighty Three Thousand Dollars, (\$8,083,000.00), or so much as may be authorized by law, is hereby assessed and levied for the anticipated objects and purposes specified against all taxable property within the limits of the SKOKIE PARK DISTRICT at full, fair cash value as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes, for the current fiscal year of said Park District, commencing on 1ST DAY OF MAY, 2018 and ending 30TH DAY OF APRIL, 2019. The sum assessed and levied pursuant hereto shall be applied in liquidation of the appropriations made in accordance with applicable law for the fiscal year commencing 1ST DAY OF MAY, 2018 and ending 30TH DAY OF APRIL, 2019, after public hearing as required by law, or for appropriations made in accordance with applicable law for MAY, 2018 and ending 1ST DAY OF MAY, 2018 and ending 30TH DAY OF APRIL, 2019, after public hearing as required by law, or for appropriations made in accordance with applicable law for the fiscal year commencing 1ST DAY OF MAY, 2018 and ending 30TH DAY OF MAY, 2018 and ending 1ST DAY OF MAY, 2018 and ending 0 30TH DAY OF MAY, 2018 and ending 0 30TH DAY OF MAY, 2018 and ending 0 30TH DAY OF APRIL, 2019.

SECTION 2: Pursuant to Section 4-4 of the Park District Code, (70 ILCS 1205/4-4), as amended, this levy is not intended or required to be supportive of or in relation to the Park District's Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the 1ST DAY OF MAY, 2018 through the 30TH DAY OF APRIL, 2019 fiscal year.

SECTION 3: Hereafter set forth under the column entitled "Amount to be Raised by Taxation" is the specific amount hereby levied for each object and purpose.
