

Party like a Troll!



The Trolls sure know how to throw a party—and you can, too! Whether with your household or over video-chat with friends, use some of these fun crafts, snacks, and activities to get your grove on during the Trolls World Tour!

Popcorn

What's a party without snacks? Try out some of these colorful popcorn recipes, or create your own!

Birthday Cake Popcorn:

- 2 bags microwavable kettle corn or white popcorn
 - 1-1/2 cups white chocolate chips or vanilla candy melts
 - 1/4 cup vegetable oil
 - 1-1/2 cup white or yellow cake mix
 - 1/3 cup rainbow sprinkles
1. Pop the popcorn in the microwave, following packaging instructions. Transfer popcorn to a large bowl, being careful to pick out all of the un-popped kernels.
 2. Melt the white chocolate chips or candy melts in the microwave in 30 second intervals, stirring between each 30 seconds until it is fully melted.
 3. Stir in the vegetable oil to the melted chocolate until smooth. Then add the cake mix to the chocolate - the mixture will be thick, but mix until well-incorporated.



4. Drizzle the chocolate/cake batter mixture over the popcorn and add half of the sprinkles. Toss everything together until evenly coated.
5. Spread the popcorn onto wax paper-lined cookie sheets to allow the chocolate to harden and sprinkle the remaining sprinkles on top.
6. Let popcorn harden for about 20 minutes on the counter, or 5 minutes in the fridge, and enjoy!

Peanut Butter and Jelly Popcorn:

- 8 cups popped popcorn
 - 1 cup white chocolate, divided
 - 1 1/2 tbsp. grape jelly
 - 1 tbsp. peanut butter
1. Divide Popcorn into two separate bowls.
 2. Over medium low heat on the stove top, melt 1/2 cup white chocolate with 1 tbsp. peanut butter. Stir until smooth. Pour over 1 bowl of the popcorn. Use a rubber spatula to mix well and coat thoroughly. Spread out on a silicon mat or parchment paper to let cool.
 3. Meanwhile, melt the remaining 1/2 cup white chocolate with 1 1/2 tbsp grape jelly over medium low heat on the stove top. Stir until smooth. Pour over the other bowl of popcorn, and stir with rubber spatula to coat well. Spread out on silicon mat or parchment paper to let cool.
 4. Once both batches of popcorn are cooled enough that the coatings are set, mix them both together in a bowl and serve



Sweet and Salty Popcorn:

- 1 bag of popped popcorn about 10 cups
 - 2 cups peanuts
 - 1 cup M&M candies
 - 3/4 cup light corn syrup
 - 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter
 - 1 1/2 cup sugar
 - 1 tsp vanilla
 - 1 cup chocolate chips
1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees.



- Pop the popcorn and set aside in a large bowl.
- Combine corn syrup, butter, sugar, and vanilla over medium heat in a small saucepan.
- Stir frequently until mixture is smooth and completely melted.
- Mix peanuts with popcorn.
- Pour the warm sugar mixture over the popcorn and peanuts.
- Stir until well coated, and turn out onto a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper.
- Arrange popcorn in a single layer and bake for 15 minutes.
- Remove from the oven and top with half the M&M candies (and sprinkles, optional).
- Stir once, and top with remaining M&M candies.
- Melt the chocolate chips and drizzle over popcorn.
- Allow to chill in the refrigerator or freezer until the chocolate is hard set.
- Break into pieces and enjoy!

Troll Hair

Now it's time to look the part! No matter how long your hair is, you can always try something funky with colorful hairspray and clips!

Supplies:

- Regular hairspray
- Small rubber bands
- Comb
- Bobby pins
- Colored hairspray (usually in the dye section)
- A plastic cup
- Stretchy headband



How-To:

- Comb hair until smooth. Part hair at crown, and part over towards the face.
- Place cup upside down on top of the head. If your hair is shorter than the cup, you can just cut the cup shorter! Holding the cup with one hand, scoop the front strip of hair up into an upward sweeping motion. Don't let go, just keep working until you have covered the cup completely with loose hair.
- Using a small rubber band, gather up the top sprig of hair, located at the bottom of the cup, and tie. Use a stretchy headband to secure the style. Don't be afraid to use the hairspray, and bobby pins! It may look messy at first, but you can smooth out later.
- Once you have your Troll silhouette complete and to your liking, pull out your colored spray and get busy!



Make Some Music

Making music is a huge part of being a Troll! Follow these directions to make your own instruments, or get creative and come up with your own!

Make a drum by covering a coffee can, bowl, or another round object with a stretched-out balloon!



Make castanets by gluing bottle-caps to a strip of cardboard! Just fold the cardboard in half so the bottle caps can click together.



Make a shake stick with just a toilet paper or paper towel roll! Close one end, add beans or beads, tape the other end, and decorate. Shake away!
