

The Devonshire Playhouse – Teen Performers Audition Notes for *Urinetown, The Musical*

Welcome to the Skokie Park District Devonshire Playhouse auditions for *Urinetown, The Musical.* Auditions are open to ages 12-18. Auditions are by appointment, but walk-ins will be accepted as time allows.

Music Auditions

Prepare 16-32 bars of a song that is in the style or spirit of *Urinetown*. Please have your sheet music or backing tracks prepared. An accompanist and a digital player will be provided.

Scenes

Dance Auditions

Dance will also be included in auditions with "Run Freedom Run." Please be sure to wear comfortable clothes and shoes to move in.

Callbacks

If needed, these will be conducted on September 5 from 7:30-9P. Not receiving an invitation to callbacks does not mean that you will not be cast. It only means that we need a second look at certain actors together, in order to make final decisions. For callbacks, auditionees will sing music and read sides from the show. Copies of music being used in callbacks are included in this packet. Scene sides will be distributed at callbacks.

Rehearsal Schedule & Potential Conflicts

- 1st rehearsal is Tuesday, September 9 / 6-9P. Regular rehearsals run M, T & W / 6-9P from 9/15 to 11/5. Weekday rehearsals could begin by 5P in October.
- Sunday rehearsals are: 9/14- 11/2 from 1-5P (Exceptions: No rehearsal on 10/5 (this will be held on Saturday, 10/4 from 1-5P)
- Some Saturday afternoon rehearsals could occur in October but these would be in lieu of Wednesdays.
- Technical Rehearsals are: Sunday, 11/9 from 1-5P and Monday-Thursday, 11/10-13 from 6-9:30P with a pick up rehearsal on W 11/19 from 6-9P.
- Cast members are expected to be at every rehearsal during the final two weeks prior to performance, 11/2-13.
- A more detailed schedule is released after casting is complete. Be sure to list all potential conflicts on the conflict calendar included in this packet.
- A calendar is included in this packet for you to mark your conflicts and hand in with your audition application.

Role Offers

We will send role offers out starting Saturday, September 6 and will complete the process by Monday, September 8. Actors should respond to cast offerings as soon as possible.

Please refrain from posting any roles offered until the official cast list is released. The release will be emailed to the entire cast.

Performance Dates

Saturdays November 15 & 22 with Actors' call at 5:30P and performance beginning at 7P. Plus Sundays, November 16 & 23 with Actors' call at 1:30P and performance at 3P.

Strike

Those who are cast should plan to assist with strike following the final performance.

Production Fees

If cast, you should be prepared to pay a production fee of \$236-Residents/\$295-Non Residents. This fee helps to underwrite the total cost of costumes, sets, script/music purchase and/or rental, and props. You would register as a cast member at our front desk by the first rehearsal and make the production fee payment at that time. All cast members receive 2 complimentary tickets, a show poster and digital photographs of the show. If two members of a household are cast, then the 2nd family member receives a 15% discount on their production fee. The third household member would receive a 25% discount. Production Fees are due by the end of the first rehearsal week on Monday, September 16.

Character Breakdown for Urinetown The Musical

Officer Lockstock: The tongue-in-cheek narrator of our story, he is a corrupt policeman who secretly kills off the guilty offenders. Bold, brash, and larger than life in many ways.

Penelope Pennywise: The tough, jaded warden of the poorest, filthiest town urinal. She is Cladwell's one-time lover and mother to Hope who eventually softens her temper.

Bobby Strong: The dashing, rebellious everyman who works for Miss Pennywise at the poorest, filthiest town urinal. He becomes an unsuspecting protagonist and romantic hero when he starts a revolution and falls in love with Hope Cladwell.

Little Sally: A precocious and irreverent street urchin. She serves as a quasi-narrator who often questions Lockstock and the play's logic.

Joseph "old Man" Strong: Bobby's rebellious father. His refusal to pay the fee sends him to Urinetown, ultimately launching the revolution. Optional Doubling as HOT BLADES HARRY.

Tiny Tom: One of the Poor, he is an idiotic man-child. Optional Doubling as DR. BILLEAUX.
