Skaters will not be admitted into the next higher class without having been tested by a Skatium class teacher. Skaters who have passed USFSA Free Skate 6 must register for the Pre-Bronze level. Bronze, Silver and Gold registrants will need to demonstrate the class skills from their last test level on the first day of class to certify their ability to participate in a high level class.
