Skokie Water Playground — COVID-19 Rules

- Pre-registration tickets will be required to enter the facility for Skokie residents only.
 Tickets can be purchased online at www.skokieparks.org.
- Residents of Skokie may purchase tickets up to five (5) days in advance. Non-Residents may purchase any remaining session tickets on the day of visit.
- Any available tickets can be purchased one (1) hour after the beginning of any swim session.
- There are no season passes, you must pay as you go. Any use of a Splash pass must be accompanied with the purchase of at least 1 ticket.
- While outside of the water in common areas, participants must wear face coverings over their nose and mouth when within 6-ft of others.
- To enter the facility, swimmers will use the gate entrance on the east side of the pool near the softball fields.
- To exit the facility, swimmers will use the gate in the rear of the facility or the exit turnstile.
- It is recommended that you come to the facility with your swim attire on and only use the locker rooms only for bathroom breaks. Locker rooms will only be accessible from the pool deck.
- It is recommended that showering be done at home. Some showers will be available in each locker room.
- Swimmers must arrive as close as possible to their time-slot scheduled start time and have their tickets ready.
- There is no congregating on the pool deck, changing areas, or entrance and exit area. While on deck you will be expected to keep a 6-ft. social distance from all other groups in the pool area.
- Deck chairs will be provided and are set in groups of 2 or 4, in a socially distanced manner. Please Do not move chairs. Deck chairs will be cleaned between sessions. It is encouraged that you bring your own chairs from home.
- All public water fountains will be closed. Patrons may bring in their own food and drink, alcohol is prohibited. The Park District will have trash cans available on deck for you to dispose of your trash. You are expected to leave your deck area as you found it.
- If the facility opens as scheduled, no refunds will be given for those who registered but chose not to attend.
- In the case there is inclement weather and the facility is unable to open, all who registered for that day will receive a refund. Decisions about opening and closing the facility will be at the sole discretion of the Park District staff. - With the limited number of spaces available for each time slot, everyone who wishes to enter the facility will have to pay the entry fee. There will not be any age exemptions.
