In-district fees apply to Skokie & Morton Grove residents. Non-resident figure skating fees apply to all other areas. Please make checks payable to the Skokie Park District. Refunds will not be given after the 3rd class. There will be a \$5 service charge to all refunds. Two make-up classes are permitted each semester. Student/teacher ratio for Snowplow Sam classes is 10 tots per 1 instructor. Ratio for Basic 1 & up classes is 16 students per 1 instructor. Skate Rental for classes is \$2.50 per pair. Classes can only be pro-rated if a student is starting a semester after the session has begun. The Skatium is proud to follow the United States Figure Skating (USFS) Learn to Skate USA program. The Skatium will be registering all new skaters with the USFS program. Anyone not wanting to be registered should contact Kerry Murphy in writing prior to the first day of the fall 2016 semester.

Intro to Free Skate Through Gold

Intro to Free Skate through Gold level students (ages 6-19) must register according to the last Compulsory test level passed. Enroll one class higher than the last test passed, unless approved by the skating director. If in doubt, register for the class your child was in for spring 2016; we will advance your child when they are tested. Remember only those skaters registered in classes are permitted to perform in the Skatium's annual ice show. Also, only skaters registered in Free Skate 6 and higher who are registered for the fall 2016, winter 2016 and spring 2017 will be permitted to try-out for a solo in the 2017 ice show.

Skaters will not be admitted into the next higher class without having been tested by a Skatium class teacher.

Skaters who have passed USFS Free Skate 6 must register for the Bronze level. The class level Instructor will then determine which skaters should be placed in the Silver or Gold Classes. Selection will be based on skill level.

Bronze, Silver and Gold registrants will need to demonstrate the class skills from their last test level on the first day of class to certify their ability to participate in a high level class. Skaters who do not meet the requirements for the class will be placed in the appropriate level.

Class Skate Rental Pre Paid Convenient Card

This easy & convenient card is only for **skates rented for classes**. Eleven week skate rental card can be purchased for \$27.50. There is no expiration on the card. Refunds can not be given for lost or stolen cards. If cards are forgotten or left at home on a particular day skaters or parents will need to pay for rental skates on that day.

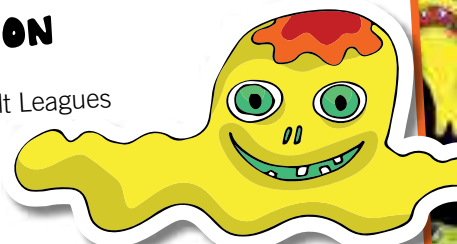

Important! It is a requirement by all leagues that all Flyers players be a registered, sanctioned player with the national governing body of amateur hockey in the United States – USA Hockey. To become registered you must register from their website at www.usahockeyregistration.com. When registering, there is a fee to USA Hockey of \$53 per player. Your Skokie Park District Flyers house league registration cannot be accepted without you first inputting your 2016-17 USA Hockey registration number on the registration form. Thank you.

In accordance to the NSYHL & NWHL rules, a player may not be rostered to a AAA, AA or A travel hockey roster and a house league roster at the same time.

Our Flyers Youth House League Program is now requiring ADVANCED CONCUSSION TESTING for all of our players Pee Wees, Bantams & Midget age levels. The health of our players is first and foremost. We all know about the elevated concerns surrounding concussions and head trauma. There are now new protocols in both professional and youth sports.

Skokie Hockey, both travel and house league is the first hockey organization in Chicago and one of the first organizations in the country to purchase BNA (Brain Network Activation) testing for all of our players ages eleven and older. It is an FDA cleared test that provides medical professionals and parents a more scientific based measure as to how an impact has affected brain function. While we are utilizing BNA baseline testing for hockey, if any player sustains an injury playing a different sport, bike riding, or just has an accident around the house, he/she can receive an unlimited amount of follow-up tests (at no charge) to help determine the severity of the injury. Thus, for their peace of mind, parents can have a child re-tested as often as they want for a 12-month period from the date of the baseline test.

The test itself takes only seventeen minutes and involves putting a non-invasive net over the players head as he/she does the testing. In essence, it is like an EEG for the child's brain. If the child sustains an accident at home, or school or on the ice, the player can return to ATHLETICO to scientifically measure the potential functional difference of the brain due to the perceived head trauma. There is no longer a need to say "I think he is OK..." Now a family and a medical doctor can have scientific based information without any additional cost for the follow-up testing. The initial cost of this BNA testing is incorporated in the fee for our program.
