# FUTURE FLYERS INSTRUCTIONAL HOCKEY PROGRAM

This program is for players with a goal of joining our Flyers House League program but have little or no current hockey or skating experience. These classes take the beginning skater from standing on skates to the execution of basic forward, backward skating and the skills needed to meet their goal of entering our Flyers House League.

Protective equipment required for this class is provided as part of this class. This includes helmet with facemask, elbow pads, shin guards and hockey gloves. Skate Rental is available for \$3 per class.


