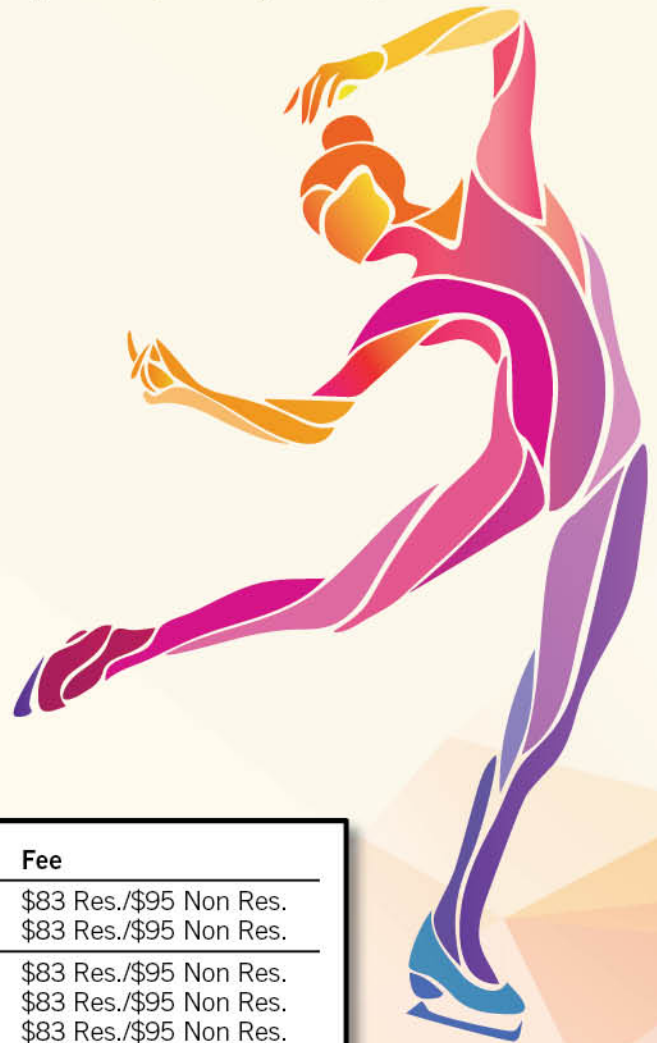

In-district fees apply to Skokie & Morton Grove residents. Non-resident figure skating fees apply to all other areas. Please make checks payable to the Skokie Park District. Refunds will not be given after the 3rd class. There will be a \$5 service charge to all refunds. Two make-up classes are permitted each semester. Student/teacher ratio for Snowplow Sam classes is 10 tots per 1 instructor. Ratio for Basic 1 & up classes is 16 students per 1 instructor. Skate Rental for classes is \$2.50 per pair. Classes can only be pro-rated if a student is starting a semester after the session has begun. The Skatium is proud to follow the United States Figure Skating (USFS) Basic Skills program. The Skatium will be registering all new skaters with the USFS program.

Convenient Class Skate Rental Card

Class Skate Rental Pre Paid Convenient Card – This easy & convenient card is only for **skates rented for classes**. Ten week skate rental card can be purchased for \$25.00. There is no expiration on the card. Refunds cannot be given for lost or stolen cards. If cards are forgotten or left at home on a particular day skaters or parents will need to pay for rental skates on that day.

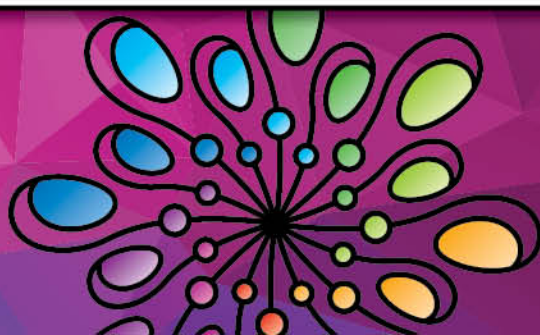

Intro To Pre Free Skate through Gold

Intro To Pre Free Skate through Gold level students (ages 6-19) must register according to the last Compulsory test level passed. Enroll one class higher than the last test passed, unless approved by the skating director. If in doubt, register for the class your child was in for fall 2017; we will advance your child when they are tested. Remember only those skaters registered in classes are permitted to perform in the Skatium's annual ice show. Also, only skaters registered in Bronze and higher who are registered for the fall 2017, winter 2017 and spring 2018 will be permitted to try-out for a solo in the 2018 ice show. In order for a Kaleidoscope 6 skaters to be eligible to register for the Ice Show Bronze level they must pass the Kaleidoscope 6 skills and have been registered in 8 consecutive Free Skate 6 class (not including summer).

Free Skate 6 skaters will not be admitted into the Bronze class without being tested by the Skating Director or the Assistant Skating Director

Bronze, Silver and Gold registrants will need to demonstrate the class skills from their last test level on the first day of class to certify their ability to participate in a high level class. Skaters who do not meet the requirements for the class will be placed in the appropriate level.

PRACTICE RECOMMENDATION FOR FREE SKATE SKATERS !

Once a child reaches the Free Skate class level the skills become more challenging which is why the Skatium recommends skaters in the Intro to Free Skate – Free Skate 2 practice at least one additional day separate from their class. Skaters Free Skate 3-Free Skate 5 should practice 2 hours a week and those in Free Skate 6 & up should practice 3-4 times a week.

Kaleidoscope Class

This class is designed for skaters who have very busy schedules, who love to skate and enjoy the challenge. Learning non testing skills, such as Bauers, spread eagles, split & stag jumps, twizzles, side layback, split falling leaf & one foot axels. This is not a skill based program, it's a class for skaters who no longer wish to test through the various levels.

Kaleidoscope Silver is for skaters considered Free Skate 2 through Free Skate 4.

Kaleidoscope Gold is for skaters considered Free Skate 5 & Up

Skaters registered for the Silver class would need to be evaluated and approved by Kerry in order to move up to the Gold Class. Skaters wishing to participate in the annual ice show would need to have placement approval by their Kaleidoscope teacher for which show level skaters should register for.

Private lessons are available at the Skatium by simply filling out a request form in the Skatium office. For skaters who make arrangements through the Skatium's Skating Director and who are registered in Skatium classes, fees are as follows:

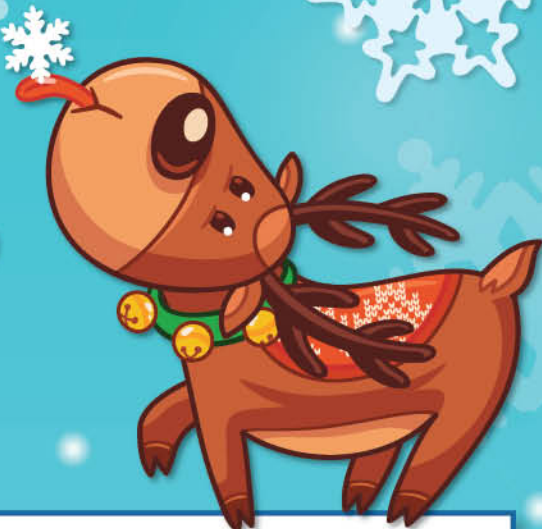

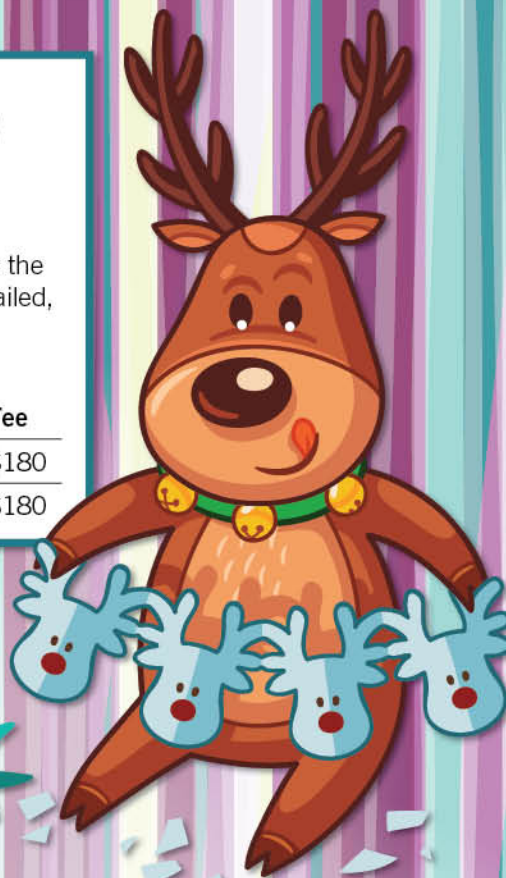
